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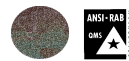

Description: PINEMUL® 200 invert mud secondary emulsifier is comprised of carboxylterminated polyamide and glycol ethers.

Applications: PINEMUL® 200 is a concentrated secondary emulsifier used for formulating invert drilling fluids. It will provide high emulsification and oil wetting. PINEMUL® 200 is commonly used with primary mud emulsifier such as PINEMUL® 101.

Usage: Dilute to field strength with synthetic oil, ester or olefins for ease in handling. For a 25 - 50% active dilution field strength product, use 2 - 8 pounds/bbl. Mix according to standard mixing procedure. A primary emulsifier is required to form a stable emulsion.
